Heartsaver[®] CPR AED

The Heartsaver[®] CPR AED course teaches how to recognize cardiac arrest, get emergency care on the way quickly, use cardiopulmonary resuscitation and an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) until more advanced care arrives to take over. The course also covers adult choking, CPR and AED use for children, infant CPR, child and infant choking.

After successfully completing this course, students should be able to:

- Describe how high-quality CPR improves survival
- Explain the concepts of the Chain of Survival
- Recognize when someone needs CPR
- Perform high-quality CPR for an adult
- Describe how to perform CPR with help from others
- Give effective breaths using mouth-to-mouth or using a mask for all age groups
- Demonstrate how to use an AED on an adult
- Describe when and how to help a choking adult and child

Heartsaver® First Aid

This course covers first aid basics, consisting of the most common medical, injury and environmental emergencies, how to recognize them, how to call for help, and how to perform lifesaving skills.

After successfully completing this course, students should be able to:

- List the priorities, roles, and responsibilities of first aid rescuers
- Describe the key steps in first aid
- Find the problem
- Describe the assessment and first aid actions for medical emergencies such as breathing problems, choking, bad allergic reactions, fainting, diabetic emergency, stroke, seizure, and shock
- Handle injury and environmental emergencies, including external bleeding, broken bones and sprains, bites and stings, and poisoning
- Use an epinephrine pen
- Control bleeding and bandage
- Describe how to find information on preventing illness and injury
